Read this section to learn about what kinds of help you can get with money.

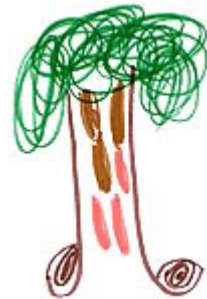
